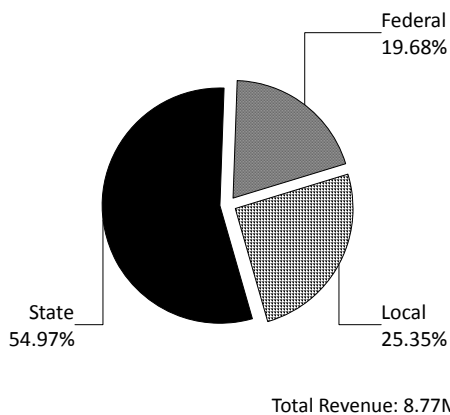

**Revenue Sources**



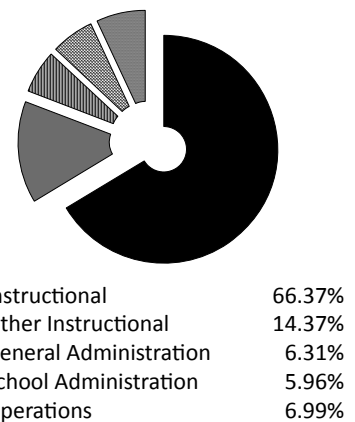
